LOTT's Annual Report 2024

LOTT Clean Water Alliance (LOTT) released its 2024 Annual Report, showcasing a year of growth and achievement and concluding the 2019-2024 planning cycle. Year over year, LOTT evaluated performance on 10 performance objectives and 20 priorities to measure utility progress. For 2024, LOTT met nearly all performance objectives and excelled in permit compliance, community engagement and emergency preparedness.

"These achievements reflect our ongoing dedication to protecting our community and the environment," shared Executive Director Matt Kennelly. "As we enter the next planning cycle, we are focusing on LOTT's resiliency by optimizing our resources – people, infrastructure, processes and partnerships – to efficiently, effectively and responsibly manage these community assets."

The 2024 Annual Report highlights include:

- Providing the highest level of wastewater treatment on Puget Sound for nearly 140,000 people
- Treating over 4.4 billion gallons of wastewater
- Meeting 100% of all pollutant limit permit requirements at the Budd Inlet Treatment Plant
- Welcoming over 12,000 participants in LOTT's educational programming, including visitors to the WET Science Center
- Producing over 163 million gallons of reclaimed water
- Generating over 2 million kilowatt hours of energy for use at LOTT's downtown Olympia facilities and to heat the Hands On Children's Museum
