LOTT Clean Water Alliance (LOTT) is the regional wastewater utility for the cities of Lacey, Olympia and Tumwater in Thurston County, Washington. At the heart of LOTT's education and outreach program is the WET Science Center. WET stands for Water, Education and Technology. The center offers various programs to educate the community about water and the environment. In September, community members are invited to visit the learning center and participate in LOTT's Saturday programs.
