## Capitol Lake Pump Station

### Project

This project replaces the coatings in the Capitol Lake Pump Station wet wells and equipment in the pump station. Wet wells are coated to protect concrete from hydrogen sulfide, which can come from raw sewage. The current coatings have begun to fail, creating the risk of concrete deterioration and pump blockages.

### Project Benefits

This work will ensure the longevity of the pump station is maintained and will continue to move wastewater from Tumwater and the west side of Olympia to the Budd Inlet Treatment Plant.

### Timeline

This project will run from May through October 2026.

### Anticipated Impacts

There will be additional traffic, noise, and temporary construction equipment at the pump station property. Overnight activity is anticipated the end of July and again in late September.

Contractors will maintain access for neighbors and emergency vehicles at all times. Please be alert and cautious when driving through this area.
